5-7 years old


8-10 years old

# Frequently Asked Questions

---

**Q: Who is invited to this event?**

**A:** All of the residents of Emerald Estates and their families.

**Q: Who is sponsoring/paying for this event?**

**A:** This is paid for personally by your neighbors who want to have fun at the park. There will not be an added charge on your water bill. If you would like to contribute to this event, whether by volunteering or financially, please contact Megan C. DeBruler.

**Q: Why do the age ranges only go up to 10 years old?**

**A:** This event is primarily for little kids. 10 year old's are more than welcome to help set up this event by hiding the eggs, or even stuffing the eggs prior to the event.

**Q: What will be in the eggs? How many eggs will there be? What is the park is still covered in snow?**

**A:** Candy! Roughly 200 eggs. The event will be canceled if the park is still covered in snow.

**Q: How will the grass lawn be sectioned off?**

**A:** There will be traffic cones and "caution" tape strung between them to indicate a section, with balloons attached to the traffic cones that will indicate what age range the section is intended for.

**Q: How can you guarantee that kids older than 10, won't jump in and start grabbing all the eggs? What if kids start grabbing all the eggs from an age section that they aren't supposed to?**

**A:** Honor system people. We hope that parents will be present with their kids and be mindful of all the families who are there to have a good time.

**Q: Do we need to provide our own baskets for collecting eggs? Can we take the eggs home?**

**A:** Yes! Please provide your own basket. You can take the eggs home, but if you would like to have this event next year, then please return them to the provided/labeled bins at the park. Feel free to keep the candy though!

**Q: What about clean up after this event?**

**A:** We hope that people will clean up after themselves, as they normally would after using the park. Again, the neighbors who want to have fun will be there to help clean up the park after the event.
